### **Highlights of the 2020 American Heart Association's ...**

These data are, of course, from babies born 10 years ago. Even though neonatal clinical science has not changed that much, attitudes can change much more quickly! In Canada in 2012 about 9% of babies delivering alive at 24weeks gestation had palliative care instituted at birth, in 2019 that was 6%.
