Spectrophotometric Determination of Iron

Warm up the spectrophotometer 15 min. before use. Prepare standards from bovine serum albumin, preferably calibrated using absorbance at 280 nm and the extinction coefficient. Using 5 ml color reagent to 1 ml sample a recommended range is 0.5 to 20 mg protein. Prepare a reference tube with 1 ml buffer.

Ammonium formate does not leave any residues as it decomposes to volatile compounds during the drying process (e.g. 2 h at 100°C). The results can be expressed as dry weight per volume or, when combined with a determination of the cell concentration, per algal cell (see Worksheet 2.3.).

2.3. Algal production

The blue color is masked by the yellow color from the excess reagent giving a final green-colored solution. The intensity of the color is directly related to the amount of ammonia nitrogen present. Potentiometric titration is a traditional and definitive method for p K a determination. A diagram of this approach is shown in Figure 24.6. The compound is dissolved in water and titrated with an acidic or basic buffer of known molarity. In the classical potentiometric method, the pH of the test solution changes as the titrant is added.
