If you're playing a note on the 3rd fret, get your finger as close to the 3rd fret as you possibly can. This allows the cleanest, sharpest tone. You don't want to be on the actual fret, just right behind it. Remember, if you're playing the 3rd fret you want to be between the 2nd and 3rd frets, you finger as close to the 3rd as possible.

For instance, a hammer-on labeled for the A string might be "2h3." In that case, you'd place your finger on the 2nd fret of the A string, pluck the string, and then quickly place a different finger on the 3rd fret of the A string as you lift up the finger on the 2nd fret. Sometimes, hammer-ons are also noted with a "^" symbol.

That basic shape covers the bottom three strings, so all you have to add is the open G-string and A on the 2nd fret, G-string: Next, work on studying all the natural notes up to the 5th fret . That step just adds all the notes on the 5th fret and two on the 4th fret, G and C strings to what we already have from the previous step.

For example, if you find a note on the 4th string, the same note lies three frets higher on the 2nd string. If you find a note on the 5th string, the same note lies two frets higher on the 3rd string, or two frets lower on the 2nd string. We can also see that the 1st and 6th strings create the same note at the same fret.

The 1st fret is the one closest to the head of the guitar. Frets are numbered in order from 1-22. When practicing the basics of the guitar, count the frets to familiarize yourself with their placement. When you place your finger on a fret the key or sound of the string will change. Each fret results in a different note for every string.

The number on the line corresponds to the fret (note) to be played. Examples: When you see the first note of 'Stand By Me' is a 2 on the middle line, you will know to play the 2nd fret on the G string for one eighth note. The second note shows a 0 on the 2nd line, which tells us to play the open B string for another eighth note.

The root note can be on an open string. In the case of the E minor pentatonic box, the first fret of the pattern should be the open strings (or the 12th fret if you want to play an octave up). Similarly, the G major box pattern, should be rooted on the open 3rd string or 12th fret of the 3rd string. I hope this helps!
