The key rule for good writing is brevity. Short, simple and clear. Use short and simple sentences. Sentences should be no longer than 15 words and should be without clauses.

Choose one phrasing style for the headings, and write them all the same way (in parallel structure). Use a separate numbered entry for each step. It's OK to combine short steps that occur in the same place in the UI. Most of the time, include actions that finalize a step, such as OK or Apply buttons.

How to . . . Teach Instruction and Explanation Text

The Instructional Design Document captures the consensus about the global instructional approach to be adopted among the key players of the project. It documents how the course structure, navigation, or design should be, the audio and visual elements to be used, and so on.

An Outline For Creating An Instructional Design Document ...

Write an introductory paragraph telling the reader what he will accomplish by following your instructions. For example, if you are writing about "How to Knit a Scarf," write down three or four benefits of the finished scarf and include them in your introduction. Convert the steps you identified in your "dry run" into paragraphs.
